

3 STEP VISION STUDY QUESTIONS

FOR PERSONAL GROWTH OR DISCUSSION

MARCH 4, 2018

SHARING: Of all the ideas that were covered this weekend, which were most impactful or of interest to you? Which part of the 3 Step Vision resonated the most deeply with you?

- 1 What stood out to you in John's message this last Sunday?

- 2 Read Genesis 12:1-9.
 - A God clearly calls Abram to "Go." Is there a time in your life (that you're able to share) when you sensed God calling you out from comfort, family, or security to follow His leading?

 - B What was the motivation or reason behind God moving you? How many of you discovered this motivation or reason only after you took the steps of obedience and reflected backwards?

 - C In verses 2-3, God tells Abram what He is going to do. God will bless Abram so that in turn the world will be blessed through him. In what ways is this true of your life? How has God blessed you, or positioned your life, so in turn you can be a blessing to others?

 - D In verse 7, Abram would never see the people (his descendants) take the land God had promised to him. Abram's steps of faith were not about him. His steps of faith were for people he would never meet. Do you think God still asks you to take steps of faith today that, in turn, will bless generations beyond your lifetime? How do you feel about that?

- 3 Read the story of the conversation between God and Moses at the burning bush in Exodus 3:1-15.
- A What would have to change in the life of Moses in order to fulfill what God was calling him to do? What did Moses sacrifice to be involved?

 - B Why was God calling Moses to go? What was the “why” behind his action? How did Moses benefit from following?

 - C What was the “why” behind the 3 Step Vision you heard this weekend?
- 4 In Matthew 28:16-20, we find what is known as the Great Commission. In Greek, the word “nations” is “ethnos,” which can also be translated “peoples” in English. Jesus puts His church on mission and it’s all about people. What is God calling you to do, as part of His church, with the people in your life? What is our action step toward them?
- 5 Have someone recap the 3 Step Vision presented in services this weekend. Which area are you most excited about? What area would you like to be involved with?
- 6 Just as Abraham (Abram), Moses, and the Disciples all sacrificially gave of their time, talents, money, and lives to follow God’s calling, what do you think it will look like for you to sacrificially join God in where He is leading our Heights family? What would it look like for you to sacrificially give to the vision ahead of us?
- 7 Close by praying for our Heights family, the vision in front of us, and the “unseen” people that will be impacted through our sacrificial obedience to follow God into where He is calling us.
