



- 4 Read 2 Peter 1:12-13. Peter is writing under the inspiration of the Spirit, and is eager to remind his readers of the truth, to refresh their memory, even though he realized that they already knew what he was telling them.
- A Why do you think we need these kinds of reminders?
- B Of all of the truths of the Bible that the Holy Spirit inspired, which important ideas are you most likely to forget? What happens when you do?

- A The Lord's Supper was the Passover meal that Jesus took with His disciples. It was already meant to serve as a reminder. What did the Israelites remember as they took that meal every year?
- B Jesus gave new significance to the bread and the cup. In what ways does the Lord's Supper stir up your memory? What qualities of Jesus, and what words of Jesus, does it bring to your mind?
- 6 In what ways do you hope to see change in your life as the Holy Spirit brings Jesus to your mind? How can you cooperate with His project?
