



- 3 The song “So Will I” includes this phrase: “God of salvation, you chased down my heart through all of my failure and pride.” What did God have to do (assuming that He has already done that) to “chase down” your heart?
- 4 Peter had an incredible failure before the crucifixion when he denied knowing Christ, and 1 Corinthians 15:5 says that after the resurrection, “He appeared to Cephas (Peter), and then to the Twelve.” We don’t have a record of that meeting between Jesus and Peter in the gospels, but it’s interesting to imagine what it might have been like. What do you think Peter might have said, and what do you think Jesus might have said?
- 5 Read the story of the conversation between Jesus and Peter after His resurrection in John 21:15-17.
- A What strikes you about this conversation?
- B Jesus focuses on Peter’s love for Him. Why do you think He does that?
- C He gives Peter an assignment (three times), to feed and care for His sheep. How do you think the parable we studied earlier would guide Peter in that task?
- 6 “So Will I” also includes this phrase; “If You gave Your life to love them, so will I.”
- A What do you think God is asking you to do in order to love people that He loves, and to bring them to Him so they are not left behind?
- B Close by praying for those people by name, and asking God to show you how the salvation that He has given TO you could pass THROUGH you to them.
